URGENT INFORMATION – STOP WORK ACTION NEXT TUESDAY, 3rd DECEMBER.

Next Tuesday, 3rd December many staff members in the Department of Education and Community have been called to a stop work meeting from 9am to 11am to discuss issues surrounding the conditions provided for student learning, roles of leaders in various schools and wages. Many staff members at Ashtonfield Public School have agreed to attend these meetings so although the school will be open there will only be <u>minimal supervision</u> available during the morning. Students will not have normal lessons and will be supervised in communal areas such as the playground, library or hall. Classes will resume as normal at 11am.




