Anyone interested in a trip to Japan?

We are asking for expression of interest by any Year 5 parents who may consider accompanying and taking part in the Maitland Grossmann High school visit to Japan next year. This trip is scheduled to take place in the June /July school holidays in 2019.

As part of the Japanese program at our school, we are invited to join with our feeder school, Maitland Grossmann High School on their biannual educational trips to Japan.

Maitland Grossmann High run a Japanese program at their school and they have 2 sister schools in Japan that they interact with on an annual, basis, with students & teachers either travelling from Japan or to Japan each year. As part of the excursion, they visit these schools, spending time with their Japanese counterparts. There is also extensive sightseeing and experiences of the country itself.

CLASS ORGANISATION 2019


