

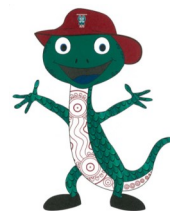

HIGH PERFORMANCE - HIPE FOOTBALL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Maitland FC is conducting a High Performance (HiPe) program that is based on refining the individual core technical skills of the players from the many Community Clubs in the Maitland district. These Community players will have their own allocated timeslot separate from the Maitland FC NPL Youth and SAP players.

The HiPe Program will use high intensity & high repetition training, concentrating on developing the four basic football skills :

- Striking the ball
- First Touch
- One v One
- Running with the ball at speed

HiPe coaching staff will come from within Maitland FC under the direction of Technical Director, Rod Haggarty.

The HiPe Program will be held at the Maitland Hockey Centre, Maitland Park on each Monday of the school term from 4.30pm to 5.20pm commencing Monday 4 February, 2019.

The cost per session is \$25 and sessions must be booked in advance by registering on our website: maitlandfc.com.au under the "HiPe Community Player" banner.
